The Nursing Program faculty at Western University in Pomona, CA, is interested in making the skills and information they present to their students clear, detailed, relevant, and accessible. Although textbooks are utilized to deliver content and to provide additional reference materials, students are the first to admit that what they hear and see in class is most likely to stick.

By using eBeam Complete, the faculty is able to display and interact with text, images, and even video during class. They utilize the Integrated Gallery to build folders of images related to class topics. In a unit on causes of and treatments for heart disease, a faculty member collects photos with heart-healthy and less heart-healthy food, people in various states of rest and activity, charts with demographic information, and types of medical and non-medical treatments.
